

Tipp Perform Well At Munster Juvenile Indoor Championships

The Munster Indoor Championships, our first Juvenile Indoor fixture took place last weekend in Nenagh for U/13 to U/17 Individual Events. The County was very well represented over the two day Championships with a total of 11 Clubs taking part. Tipperary had a great medal haul winning 59 individual medals (17 gold, 23 silver & 19 bronze) & 5 sets of Relay medals (3 gold, 1 silver & 1 bronze, Nenagh Olympic A.C. winning 2 gold, 1 silver & 1 bronze & Clonmel A.C. winning 1 gold).

Chloe Fahy, Nenagh Olympic A.C. & Shane O'Dwyer, Carrick-On-Suir A.C., recent Munster All-Stars were in top form with Chloe winning 5 medals in total (2 gold in the Girls U/17 Long Jump & High Jump, 1 silver in the 60mH & 2 bronze in the 60m & 200m). Shane won 4 medals, gold in the Boys U/17 200m & 3 silver medals in the 60m, Long Jump & High Jump. Other Tipperary athletes who shone over the weekend were Kelly Ann Doyle, Carrick-On-Suir, gold in Girls U/13 60mH, silver in the High Jump & bronze in the Long Jump; Michael Quilligan, Nenagh Olympic A.C., winner of both the Boys U/13 60m & 60mH; Darren Prout, Coolquill A.C. silver in the Boys u/13 60m, 60mH & Long Jump; Megan O'Brien, Clonmel A.C. winner of Girls U/14 800m & 3rd in the High Jump; Dan Finnerty, Nenagh Olympic A.C., gold in Boys U/15 Shot & bronze in 60mH; Sean Tobin, Clonmel A.C. winner of both the Boys U/16 800m & 1500m; Patrick Lynch, Newport A.C. winner of Boys U/16 60m & 2nd in 200m; Cliona Doyle, Clonmel A.C. silver in Girls U/17 1500m & bronze in 800m & Mel Corbett, Nenagh Olympic A.C. bronze in both the Boys U/17 60mH & 200m. Tipperary also achieved a 1, 2, & 3 in the Boys U/16 1500m with Sean Tobin, Clonmel A.C. the clear winner followed by his team-mate Michael Carey in 2nd place with Seamus Hogan, Nenagh Olympic A.C. finishing in 3rd position.

The County also had a sizable number of athletes finishing in 4th position which augers well for those events in the future. Some 4th place athletes were:-
