## County Juvenile Cross Country Relays

A very successful Relay Championship took place in Thurles on Sunday when over 200 juvenile athletes representing ten different clubs took part. The biggest representation was in the U/10 category where 22 teams took to the field between the Boys and Girls event with 20 teams at U/12 level, 10 at U/14 level and 6 at U/16 level. Honours were spread throughout the clubs with Templemore top on two wins with one win each for Moycarkey-Coolcree, Clonmel, Nenagh Olympic, Thurles Crokes and Moyne.

Victory in the Girls U/10 went to Moycarkey-Coolcree with Templemore in second and Carrick on Suir in third. In the Boys U/10 Clonmel were the victors, Nenagh Olympic second and Templemore third. Templemore were the winners of the Girls U/12 with Moyne in second and Templemore "B" third. Nenagh Olympic won the Boys U/12 event with Thurles Crokes taking the silver medals and Moyne the bronze.

The winners of the Girls U/14 event went to Templemore with Moyne in second and Newport third while Thurles Crokes won the Boys U/14 event from Templemore with Nenagh Olympic third. The mixed U/16 relay went to Moyne with Nenagh Olympic in second and Clonmel third.

Congratulations to everyone who took part and provided a great spectacle on the day.

## County Juvenile Un-Even Age Championships

All roads lead to Moyglass on Sunday next when day two of the County Juvenile Cross Country Championships take place with a 12 noon start. Following a great day of running in Two-Mile-Borris it is hoped that all clubs will travel to Moyglass and provide yet another quality competition. The distances involved on Sunday are:- G/09 – 600m, B/09 - 600m, G/11 – 1,500m, B/11 - 1,500m, G/13 – 2,500m, B/13 – 2,500m, G/15 – 3,500m, B/15 – 3,500m, G/17- 4,000m, B/17 – 5,000m, G/19 – 4,000m, B/19 – 6,000m. Individual wise the first 10 across the line at U/9, U/11 and U/13 will collect medals with the first three across the line at U/15, U/17 and U/19 earning individual medals. In the team events it is four to score at U/9, U/11 and U/13 with three to score at U/15, U/17 and U/19.
